Sunday 22nd May 2022 Sixth Sunday of Easter

Nationally Christian Aid Week will raise millions of pounds to support communities living in poverty around the world. By taking part we are helping Christian Aid to mobilise their resources quickly to where the need is greatest.

This year the appeal has focused on the work in Zimbabwe which illustrates of the kind of projects they do.

Working with partners (Non-governmental agencies) already in place, Christian Aid has already helped over 27,000 people in Zimbabwe - providing seeds for drought tolerant plants and training communities in how to cultivate the new crops. They work to build storehouses to preserve the harvested crops and help them to survive the ever-increasing droughts. Christian Aid use the money raised during Christian Aid Week wherever the need is greatest.

We know that the war in Ukraine will have an impact around the world by driving up global food prices.

Our Christian Aid Week gifts will bring hope to people facing disaster, from conflict to climate chaos, wherever they need it most. Christian Aid partners, are at work now in Ukraine, Hungary and Bulgaria, supporting Refugees and internally displaced people.

Raising unrestricted funds in Christian Aid Week means they can respond to emergencies like Ukraine immediately, even before an emergency appeal has been launched (as they did by using £2m immediately for Ukraine). The money allows Christian Aid to be there in forgotten emergencies that aren't in the news, such as Afghanistan and the middle east where their partners are still working hard.

'I have said these things to you while I am still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid. You heard me say to you, "I am going away, and I am coming to you." If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going to the Father, because the Father is greater than I. And now I have told you this before it occurs, so that when it does occur, you may believe.'
