Sunday 15th June 2025 Trinity Sunday

This Sunday we will celebrate Trinity Sunday. The Trinity is famously a theological mind-bender. Three Persons but one God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, each distinct, and yet each fully God. Ultimately though, this isn't a concept to understand, rather one to worship in wonder. It's a mystery that places an eternal communion of perfect love at the heart of creation. God is perfectly love: love in action, love in being, love in communion. St Augustine famously named the persons of the Trinity the Lover, the Beloved, and the Love Between. To say that God is Trinity is ultimately to say that God is perfectly love, for how can God be love unless there is a relationship of love within God's being.

It's a mystery, and we're not really supposed to understand it. We're supposed to worship and wonder instead. Worship the God who is an eternal communion of perfect love as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

2 Corinthians 13:11-13

Finally, brothers and sisters farewell put things in order, listen to my appeal agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the saints greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

John 16. 12-15

'I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own, but will speak whatever he hears, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. He will glorify me, because he will take what is mine and declare it to you. All that the Father has is mine. For this reason, I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.
