

The Team Parish of Christ the King St Aidan's Brunton Park Sunday 6th July 2025 Thomas the Apostle

Lots of us imagine that faith and doubt are opposing states of being. If we are experiencing doubt, that means we're excluded from the community of faith. We're on the edge of things. We stick out awkwardly. We feel scared we'll be judged, and we lose our sense of belonging. But our gospel reading about Thomas's experience gives us a very different picture of doubt and faith. Thomas's doubt does not exclude him or eject him, and he is not left hanging awkwardly, struggling to look for answers on his own. Thomas's doubt is expressed in the heart of the community of faith, and it is met with an invitation to come and experience faith for himself, just as he is, no personality facelift required. And in the end, the faith he declares is not the answer to some kind of logic puzzle or carefully considered proof, but because of a living relationship with Jesus.

Ephesians 2. 19 - end

So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling-place for God.

John 20, 24-29

But Thomas (who was called the Twin one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, 'We have seen the Lord.' But he said to them, 'Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe. A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, 'Peace be with you. Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe.' Thomas answered him, 'My Lord and my God!' Jesus said to him, 'Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe.'
